Director's Report: Director Henkel reported that there were 588 books checked out in the month of October with 140 books checked out through Overdrive. Computers were used twenty times. Some patrons still make appointments to use the library when the library is closed and Director Henkel still delivers to the Villa and to those patrons that are house bound. The Board completed their certification with the Nebraska Library Association and received their certificate which can be found at the library. The Board must acquire twenty hours of continuing education credit during the next three years to renew certification. Director Henkel applied for the Library Improvement Grant and the Youth Grants for Excellence. She should hear about these grants by mid November. Director Henkel has been weeding old books and is ordering supplies for the summer reading program. Director Henkel will also donate about \$250.00 from the library funds for Christmas gifts for the school and Villa.
